<b>Attendance</b> - 1 point for each Scout who arrives prior to 7 PM	1					
<b>Service Patrol</b> - <i>In order to receive credit for attendance, at least 1/2 of the Service Patrol members must be present by 6:45 PM to set up the meeting room. If fewer than 1/2 of the Service Patrol members are present at 6:45 PM, the Patrol loses its attendance points.</i>						
<b>Uniform</b> - 1 point for each Scout who is in full uniform at the time of the uniform inspection <i>Field Uniform</i> - shirt (with patches in correct locations), neckerchief/slide, hat, pants/shorts, belt, socks, appropriate shoes <i>Activity Uniform</i> - Troop t-shirt, hat, shorts, belt	1					
<b>Pen &amp; Notebook</b> - 5 points if <b>all</b> Scouts in the Patrol bring a pen and their notebook	5					
<b>Scout Handbook</b> - 5 points if <b>all</b> Scouts in the Patrol bring their Scout Handbook	5					
<b>Patrol Flag</b> - 5 points for bringing (and displaying) the Patrol flag at the meeting	5					
<b>Patrol Yell</b> - 5 points for having a spirited Patrol yell and using it at appropriate times during the meeting. (After the opening, during Patrol competition, etc.)	5					
<b>Patrol Binder</b> - 10 points for the PL to bring his Patrol Binder to the meeting	10					
<b>Interpatrol Competition</b> - 20 points for winning the Interpatrol Competition	20
