Bird Study	Read MB book; do reqs. 5 and 8 (bring evidence or documentation)
Camping***	Read MB book; do reqs. 8d, 9a & 9b. (bring documentation signed by Scoutmaster)
Energy	Read MB book; do req. 1a (bring article) and req. 4a, b (bring paperwork)
Environmental Science**	Read MB book; do reqs. 3e, 3f, and 4 (bring documentation)
Fish & Wildlife Management	Read MB book; do req. 6a
Fishing	Read MB book; practice knots, optional- bring your fishing rod
Forestry	Read MB book; no pre-reqs.
Insect Study	Read MB book; do req. 7
Mammal Study	Read MB book; do req. 3 (pick one and bring documentation)
Nature	Read MB book; do requirement 4a, 2 (bird feeder/house) and bring documentation
Photography	Read MB book; no pre-reqs.
Plant Science	Read MB book; do req. 4 (bring documentation)
Reptile & Amphibian Study	Read MB book; do req. 8 (bring documentation)
Search & Rescue	Read MB book; do req. 5 (bring ICS-100 completion certificate)
Soil & Water Conservation	Read MB book; do req. 7e for your neighborhood (bring documentation)
Sustainability	Read MB book; to be announced when requirements become available
Wilderness Survival	Read MB book; bring written descriptions for req. 1, bring personal survival kit (req. 5)
Woodcarving	Read MB book; minimum age 13 & must bring their Totin' Chip

NOTE: If your merit badge requires keeping specimens and you are having trouble obtaining them or need information about care/feeding, contact Mr. Paul Kazyak (410) 848-0624 for help.

Special Notes:

- Scouts may be dropped off as much as 30 minutes prior to a scheduled class.
- Scouts should be picked up not later than 5 minutes after the class time is scheduled to end.
- Registration begins 30 minutes before the scheduled meeting time each day;
- Scouts should arrive absolutely no later than 10 minutes prior to the scheduled class time.
- Parents are invited to stay and observe activities, but attendance is not necessary.
- Snacks and drinks will be provided, but Scouts should bring a bag lunch for each day.
- All MB's will involve some outside activity (rain or shine); Scouts should dress appropriately for the weather.
- *All Scouts must bring a blue card signed by their scoutmaster to be eligible to earn merit badges at this camp. Scouts should also have obtained and read the Merit Badge books for the MB's they are working on and have completed any prerequisites outlined above.*
- **Suggested pre- requisite for Environmental Science- Scouts should be First Class rank or higher.
- ***Camping: Scouts should come with backpacks packed for requirements 7b. Patrol equipment and food not required. Any Scout who hasn't completed the pre-camp requirements can work towards a partial completion for the MB.
- Class space for merit badges may fill up and Scouts will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.
