

TROOP 883 TRIP PERMISSION SLIP

Summer Camp 2015 Horseshoe Scout Reservation Rising Sun, Maryland

Summer camp is the highlight of the Scouting year - where Scouts earn the most merit badges and experience more outdoor activities in one week than is thought to be humanly possible!!

Departure: Sunday, July 5, 2015

Return: Sunday, July 12, 2015

REMEMBER: Scouts will be dismissed when all of the Troop and Patrol equipment is stored properly.

Details: Don't worry! Additional information will be provided as we get closer – some of it is still being put together by the camp, and some of it is too voluminous to send out now.

Cost:

- \$380 camp cost
- Troop camp cost (to be determined)
- Summer Camp 2015 T-Shirt (required) = assume \$15
 - The PLC will decide on the design a new shirt for summer camp 2015.
- Summer Camp T-Shirt Set (required) = assume \$45
 - This is the same t-shirt set we used at previous summer camps. If you have the shirts and they still fit you do not have to purchase another t-shirt set.



Deadlines:

- Registration *commitment* February 9, 2015
- 1st installment \$120 due by February 28, 2015
- 2^{nd} installment \$130 due by March 31, 2015
- 3rd installment \$130 due by April 30, 2015
- T-Shirt Purchases will be handled separately. Additional details are forthcoming.
- **Cancellation Date: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:** When you make your commitment on or before February 9, 2015, you will be responsible for the full trip cost. The only way to "back out" from the cost obligation is to find another Scout who will take your place. *This is a camp rule and not a Troop rule once we commit to the camp, we cannot reduce our count.*

Adults Who Wish to Attend Summer Camp:

As has been the policy in the past, the Troop will pay for a total of four adults for Summer Camp - these adults will only pay for the appropriate shirt costs. Preference is given to registered leaders – first SM and ASMs, and then Committee Chair and Committee Members.

Additional adults can attend summer camp by paying the adult fee (\$170 camp fee + t-shirt costs.

Adults are needed to accompany the group and provide transportation. Camp Horseshoe is about 70 miles (75-90 minutes) from Eldersburg.
